# **Our History**

For nearly a decade, Harbour Hope International has transformed the lives of human trafficking survivors through trauma-informed, victim-centered, and restorative care. We provide a safe, therapeutic environment that fosters healing, empowerment, and self-sufficiency. Our tailored programs equip survivors with the tools to rebuild their lives, regain independence, and achieve long-term stability.

Age 11 is the average age a child enters trafficking in the state of Florida

Only 1 in 100 victims of human trafficking ever find rescue

# **Our Solution**



## **Awareness and Education**

Through awareness events, tailored workshops, and continuous research, we equip parents, caregivers, students, and professionals with practical tools to prevent and combat trafficking.

## **Survivor Care**

We provide comprehensive case management and access to critical services; including housing, healthcare, employment support, court advocacy, and transportation. Sisterhood Initiative offers survivors a sense of belonging, celebration, and peer support, fostering healing and empowerment.



# Mentorship

This year-long program helps survivors rebuild trust, set personal goals, and develop healthy relationships. Mentors provide consistent support, modeling the value of meaningful connections and personal growth.



# **Life Skills Coaching**

We empower survivors to achieve independence through coaching on mental and emotional wellness, financial literacy, healthy nutrition and movement, and spiritual enrichment. Participants develop practical competencies while cultivating strong support systems through group and one-on-one coaching sessions.



## **Leadership Development**

Survivors develop leadership habits, articulate their core values, and create personal mission statements. This program provides a safe space for survivors to share their experiences and gain confidence in guiding themselves and others while being empowered to lead fulfilling lives.



"I believe there's a common assumption that physical safety for trafficking survivors equates to psychological and emotional safety, but that simply isn't the case. People often underestimate the depth of healing required after trafficking. Physical freedom is just the start—in my opinion, a mere 2% of the journey. The remaining 98% involves the challenging, long-term work of reclaiming your emotional and psychological recovery. " -M.M Survivor

# **Story Spotlights**

Mary's journey began with heartbreak. Placed in foster care at a young age due

to her mother's struggles with addiction, Mary and her sister endured a life of instability. While her foster family provided for her on the surface, she faced subtle but painful rejection, always feeling like an outsider. At just 19, Mary has experienced more

hardship than most people endure in a lifetime. After being kicked out of her foster home for drug use, she fell into the clutches of a trafficker who preyed on her vulnerability. What started as a promise of "protection" turned into years of exploitation.

When Mary found her way to Harbour Hope, she was understandably guarded and reluctant to trust. Therapy had only brought her more pain in the past. But through compassionate care, open conversations, and consistent support, she's beginning to take the brave steps toward healing.



G.W. mentioned how she was looking forward to going out with her mentors for her birthday but was nervous because she didn't know what to expect.

"I had a great day. I have never had a birthday like this before. We went to Olive Garden. They even got me a present. "It's a beautiful day" journal and they suggested I use it as a gratitude journal" – G.W. survivor

## THE HARBOUR COMMUNITY:

### A Vision for Sustainable Restoration

Harbour Hope envisions a holistic, sustainable community designed to provide safe housing and long-term rehabilitation for survivors of trafficking and their children. This community will offer a comprehensive range of services and housing options to support survivors at every stage of their recovery. The community will feature multi-family units and single-family cottages. Key facilities will include a Welcome Center for assessments and administration, a Medical Center for healthcare and counseling, and a Community Center offering childcare, education, and social gatherings. Additionally, the community will provide a playground for children, a chapel for spiritual care, a community garden for sustainable living, and a maker space for skill-building and entrepreneurship. A guarded entrance will ensure safety and security for all residents.


